Parents are entrusting a babysitter with a most valuable commodity. This clinic is to assist you with responsibility. It provides information to know how to handle the most common situations as well as those rarely encountered.

Babysitting can be a fun, rewarding, and often times a challenging experience. This course is also meant to give you some reassurance and safety tips as you may begin to stay home alone for the first time.

You will be provided with basic information necessary for you to handle most emergencies. Training includes American Heart Association Family and Friends CPR/Choking for infants and children and simple first aid.

Before you Babysit:

How do you know when you are ready to babysit? How do you begin? Know what expectations you should have about babysitting as well as what the parents will expect from you.

On the Job:

Children are more than just small people. They have different reactions. Learn what makes them unique and how to deal with their situations.

Babysitters can be great friends for small children. Learn to comfort a child who is crying or fearful. Learn what games are age appropriate.

Step-by-step instructions guide you through changing a diaper with success.

Stay in charge of the bedtime challenge.

Promote healthy behavior with respectful discipline techniques.

Keep safety a priority. Be prepared should an emergency arise. Know what to do for first aid.

Lunch is on your own. If you bring a bagged lunch; we do have a refrigerator available.

You must have parental supervision to leave the building.
