

Summer Swim Lessons

Registration for the summer swimming lessons at the Kiel High School Pool has begun. Payment for the lessons will need to be made in order to reserve a spot in the lessons. Phone and email requests will be replied to; however, payment will still need to be made in order to reserve a spot. Persons may register at the pool between 5:30-7:30 am or 6-8 pm on Monday through Friday or during summer school hours which are 7:30 am-2:30 pm on Mondays through Thursdays from June 12 through July 12, except there is no summer school on July 4 & 5.

The summer lessons will start on July 16 and meet Monday through Thursday until July 26. There will be no lessons on Fridays. Levels 1 through 6 will be offered at 8:00 am, 9:00 am, and 10:00 am. All level 1 through 6 classes are 45 minutes. Students must be at least 4 years old by the first day of class in order to participate in level 1. Fees are \$25 for students residing in the Kiel Area School District and \$35 for students from out-of-district. Again, fees will need to be paid in order to register for the lessons.

Our staff is committed to helping your child learn to be safe in the water and to develop his/her swimming skills. Please share with us any specific health or learning needs in advance so that we can effectively instruct your child and ensure they have a fun and safe experience.
