(MS) ARTS & CRAFTS (Grades 2-3/limit 20) - Period: 3 or 4 Cost \$12

This class will develop the natural desire that students have for being creative. We will turn ordinary materials into extraordinary art! Concepts that have been taught during the year in art classes will also be integrated into this course.

(MS) ARTS & CRAFTS (Grades 4-8/limit 20) - Period: 1 or 2 Cost \$12

Students will learn that art is found in many forms by completing projects using a variety of mediums to make creative, fun and functional art. Concepts that have been taught during the year in art classes will also be integrated into this course

(ZE) AWESOME ART (Grades KG-1/limit 20) - Period: 1, 2, 3, or 4 Cost \$10

Art is all around us. During this class, students will be encouraged to further develop their artistic abilities. We will utilize a variety of material including, but not limited to, paint, chalk, origami art and much more. We will also incorporate concepts that have been taught during the year in art classes.

(HS) COOKING (Grades 4-6/limit 20) - Period: 1, 2 or 3 Cost \$20

Good nutrition is stressed while teaching more complex cooking skills. Students will put their skills to work making a variety of foods. They will also learn organizational skills and gain nutrition information. A recipe book containing the recipes used in class will be available at the end of the course. Classes will meet in the newly remodeled Family & Consumer Education kitchens at the high school. Concepts that have been taught during the year in family and consumer economics classes will also be integrated into this course.

(HS) COOKING (Grades 7-8/limit 20) - Period: 4 Cost \$20

Students continue learning good nutrition, kitchen skills as well as organizational skills as they prepare a variety of foods. All recipes used in class will be available in the form of a cookbook at the end of the course. Classes will meet in the newly remodeled Family & Consumer Education kitchens at the high school. Concepts that have been taught during the year in family and consumer economics classes will also be integrated into this course.

(ZE) FAIRYTALES AND FABLES (Grades KG-1/limit 20) - Period: 3 Cost \$5

This class will focus on different fairytales and fables (examples Goldilocks and the 3 Bears and fractured ones like Goldi Rocks and the 3 Bears). We will be reading, discussing, writing, acting out the stories and making different art projects for the books.

*** (ZE) FOR THE LOVE OF READING (Grades 1-2/limit 18) - Period: 3 Cost \$5

If you love books and love reading books come read and talk with friends! If you choose this class and you'll read some awesome books, chat with your friends about the many adventures great books can take you on and work on projects to share the books you love! We will read books according to your interests and level, and then have a meaningful discussion while enjoying each other's company. Plan to take trips to the school library to find books to read in our book club and on your own. There will be plenty of time for silent reading of your book of choice in a nice quiet setting too!

*** (ZE) FOR THE LOVE OF READING (Grades 3-4/limit 18) - Period: 4 Cost \$5

(MS) FUN WITH TECHNOLOGY (Grades 4-8/limit 15) - Period: 1, 2, 3 or 4 Cost \$10

While having "Fun with Technology", students will explore the newest and coolest tools in technology. New this year, students will get the opportunity to use their smarts to BREAKOUT! Much like the well-known "Breakout Rooms" students will have some lock boxes they will be challenged to break into and earn cool prizes! In addition, we'll continue to use the very popular 3D Printer so be sure to think of your own creation! iPads and the OSMOs will also be available for the kids to use as well. (MS) HAMMERS, NAILS & THINGS (Grades 5-8/limit 20) - Period: 3 or 4 Cost \$15

Outdoor Side Table - Band Saw Boxes

Students will learn skills taught working with wood. Basic hand tools, along with a variety of power tools, will be utilized while creating your projects. Just bring your safety glasses, because everything is supplied for you. Concepts that have been taught during the year in technology education classes will also be integrated into this course.

(ZE) KREATIVE KINDERGARTEN (Grade 4K) - Periods: 1-4 as one continuous class Cost \$17

Teachers will increase your child's readiness for 5K kindergarten through song and movement,

reading stories, art projects, playing games, music time, and making snacks related to the weekly themes. Themes include: All About You, All About Me; Summer, Sand & Sun; A-camping We Will Go; Kindergarten Here We Come. Skills practiced include: learning letter names and sounds, learning numbers, learning rhymed words, counting by 1's and 10's. Concepts that have been taught during the year in Kindergarten classes will also be integrated into this course.

-Swim lessons for 4K students are available Periods 5 or 6, see Swim Class instructions -No door-to-door in-town 4K bus pick up

-Child must be eligible for 5K in the 2025-2026 school year.

*** (HS) Let's Put On A Show (Grades 5-8/limit 15) - Period: 1-2 Cost \$0

Students would learn the ins and outs of producing and directing a show. They will be working on all of the things that happen behind the scenes of a play/musical. This would include working on costume design, creating items for the front of the house, prop and set design, labeling, and creating items for the show Beauty and the Beast.

*** (ZE) LEVELING UP LITERACY (Grades 2-3) - Period: 1, 2 or 3 (Referrals Only) Cost \$5
Intensive skill-based reading instruction following a Structured Literacy intervention approach. The goal of the intervention is to pinpoint areas of difficulty for each student and then provide instruction and practice in those areas. Students will practice reading and writing words, phrases, sentences, and passages in order to increase their abilities, close any gaps, and grow their confidence as readers and writers.

(ZE) MAKERSPACE STUDIO (Grades K-1/limit 15) - Period: 3 or 4 Cost \$10

In our MAKERSPACE you will have the opportunity to create, invent and learn! We will explore STREAM (Science-Technology-Robotics-Engineering-Art-and Math) related activities through various projects that will have you creating, building and testing out your creations. If you're looking to have some fun over the summer, you'll want to be a part of the class!

(ZE) MAKERSPACE STUDIO (Grades 2-3/limit 15) - Period: 1 or 2 Cost \$10

In our MAKERSPACE you will have the opportunity to create, invent and learn! (ZE) MATH FOR SUCCESS (Grade 5K) - Period: 4 (Referrals Only) Cost \$5

Students needing extra help with their math skills are encouraged to enroll. This is an academic course that will offer review and reinforcement of the math curriculum with a focus on basic math facts. Concepts that have been taught during the year in math classes will also be integrated into this course.

(ZE) MATH FOR SUCCESS (Grade 1) - Period: 1 (Referrals Only) Cost \$5

Students needing extra help with their math skills are encouraged to enroll. This is an academic course that will offer review and reinforcement of the math curriculum with a focus on basic math facts. Small group instruction will include hands-on practice, math games, and strategies for problem solving. The students will also be using iReady Math. Concepts that have been taught during the year in math classes will also be integrated into this course.

(ZE) MATH FOR SUCCESS (Grade 2) - Period: 1 (Referrals Only) Cost \$5

(MS) OUTDOOR GAMES (Grades 4-8/limit 20) - Period: 4 Cost \$5

Students will learn a variety of outdoor games that they will be able to play for years to come. For example, washer toss, ladder ball, croquet, steals the bacon, bean bag toss, drip, drip drop, etc. This class will be held outside in the back of the Kiel Middle school. Students are asked to dress appropriately for the weather. If it is a rainy day students will have class held in the MPR room of the middle school. Concepts that have been taught during the year in math and science classes will also be integrated into this course.

(MS) PERSONAL FITNESS (Grades 5-8/limit 30) - Period: 1 Cost \$0

Athletic Performance allows students to work in the middle or high school weight rooms during summer school. Raffles will be held weekly for gift cards and students will be entered in a summer school raffle for prizes by completing 2, 3, 4 Day workouts weekly. We will be using a combination of the Athletic Performance app and on site supervision to support students using the equipment at either building.

(ZE) READ/WRITE FOR SUCCESS (Grade 5K) - Period: 1 (Referrals Only) Cost \$5

Students needing extra help with their reading and writing skills are encouraged to enroll. This is an academic course designed to reinforce reading and writing skills taught during the school year. Concepts that have been taught during the year in literacy classes will also be integrated into this course.

(ZE) READ/WRITE FOR SUCCESS (Grade 1) - Period: 2 (Referrals Only) Cost \$5

Students needing extra help with their reading and writing skills are encouraged to enroll. This is an academic course designed to reinforce reading and writing skills taught during the school year. Weekly themed units are enhanced with projects, activities and a variety of literacy genres. The focus is to keep reading and writing fun while maintaining important skills. Concepts that have been taught during the year in literacy classes will also be integrated into this course.

(ZE) READ/WRITE FOR SUCCESS (Grade 2) - Period: 3 (Referrals Only) Cost \$5

The focus is to keep reading and writing fun while maintaining important skills. Concepts that have been taught during the year in literacy classes will also be integrated into this course

(MS) ROBLOX (Grades 3-8/limit 20) - Periods: 2, 3 or 4 Cost \$5

Using ROBLOX's sandbox environment, students will earn the basics of Lua, a simple programming language used by the game to create custom features. Students will design game worlds, and create rules for play, limited by their imaginations. Students will then have the opportunity to share their game worlds online, for others to play, and in turn get a chance to play in other game worlds created by other players around the world. Concepts that have been taught during the year in science and math classes will also be integrated into this course.

*** (HS) Six: Teen Edition (Grades 9-12) - Other Schedule Cost \$40

Join us this summer for an exciting, hands-on theatre experience as we put on Six the Musical! In this dynamic summer school class, students will have the opportunity to dive into the world of one of Broadway's hottest shows. They will explore vocal techniques, choreography, and character development while performing the electrifying story of the six wives of Henry VIII. This is an auditioned production for students with strong sight reading abilities and independent music learning experience.

(ZE) SOCIAL SKILLS (Grades 2-4/limit 20) - Period: 2 Cost \$0

Increase social skills and positive interactions with peers. This course will create positive and supportive relationships with other students; demonstrate ethical decision making, social responsibility, effective oral communication skills, belief in development of whole self, and self confidence in the ability to succeed.

(ZE) SOCIAL SKILLS (Grades 5-6/limit 20) - Period: 3 Cost \$0

Increase social skills and positive interactions with peers. This course will create positive and supportive relationships with other students; demonstrate ethical decision making, social responsibility, effective oral communication skills, belief in development of whole self, and self confidence in the ability to succeed.

(ZE) SPORTS (Grades 5K-1/limit 25) - Period: 1, 2, 3, or 4 Cost \$6

Students will have "Fun in the Sun" this summer while participating in outdoor games and activities. We will learn about good sportsmanship and teamwork. <u>Gym shoes are required.</u> Concepts that have been taught during the year in physical education classes will also be integrated into this course.

(ZE) SPORTS (Grades 2-3/limit 20) - Period: 1, 2 or 3 Cost \$5

Students will enjoy a number of activities such as scooter hockey, soccer, kickball, ultimate football, softball/baseball, dodgeball, and other fun, group games. Students will practice good sportsmanship and teamwork. <u>Gym shoes are required</u>. Concepts that have been taught during the year in physical education classes will also be integrated into this course.

(MS) SPORTS (Grades 4-8/limit 25) - Period: 1, 2, 3 or 4 Cost \$6

Students will participate and learn the rules of a variety of team sports and activities while practicing good sportsmanship. <u>Gym shoes are required.</u> Concepts that have been taught during the year in physical education classes will also be integrated into this course

*** (HS) STAGE DESIGN AND PROP DEVELOPMENT (Grades 4-6/limit 15) - Periods: 1 AND 2 COST \$0

Students would learn the ins and outs of the stage crew. How to design, create, paint, and display props and scenery.

*** (HS) STAGE DESIGN AND PROP DEVELOPMENT (Grades 7-8/limit 15) - Periods: 3 AND 4 COST \$0

Students would learn the ins and outs of the stage crew. How to design, create, paint, and display props and scenery.

(HS) STARS OF TOMORROW (Grades 2-5/limit 20) - Period: 1 or 2 Cost \$10

In this class, students will learn and work on basketball skills in a fun way, by playing games. As they play, they learn and appreciate the skills and tactics needed to play basketball successfully. Games are modified to strengthen individual technique and team play. Concepts that have been taught during the year in physical education classes will also be integrated into this course.

(HS) STARS OF TOMORROW (Grades 6-8/limit 20) - Period: 3 or 4 Cost \$10

In this class, students will learn and work on basketball skills in a fun way, by playing games. As they play, they learn and appreciate the skills and tactics needed to play basketball successfully. Games are modified to strengthen individual technique and team play. Concepts that have been taught during the year in physical education classes will also be integrated into this course.

(HS) SWIMMING (Grades 4K-8/limit 60) Periods 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 or 6. More details on skill levels and bus transport found on Pages 10-11 Cost: \$13

Period: 1, 2, 3, & 4 with shuttle bus provided for MS or ZE before and after class.

Period 5 with shuttle bus to the High School pool after school day ends at 12:00 noon;

Parents must provide transportation home.

Period 6 Parents must provide transport to the pool, and home.

TEACHER'S AIDE (Grades 5-7) - Period: 1, 2, 3, & 4

We will add this "class" to your schedule if you have arranged with a teacher to help out in a class as a Teacher's Aide. Ask your teacher to contact us for registration. The class time and location will appear on your schedule. **Registration forms will be in the school office.**

VOCATIONAL AIDE (Grades 8-12) - Period: 1, 2, 3, & 4

High School students can earn .5 Credit. Responsibilities include assisting in classrooms and other learning environments, supervising students during passing time, assisting with set-up and cleanup, daily attendance is required and other duties as assigned by the teacher of summer school directors. Application Process, complete the approval for Vocational Aide/Tutor form, submit form to the guidance office as you schedule for classes, under "Subject Area for Voc. Aide/Tutor:" write "Summer School Vocational Aide" and the term which works for you.

These forms will be submitted to the summer school directors who will connect with you to determine if you are a good fit for the program and what areas you would be able to best assist our summer school program. If you have questions you may contact Mr. Ramminger at Zielanis.

(MS) WAR GAMES (Grades 4-8/limit 20) - Period: 1 Cost \$5

Whether it's one-on-one games like Stratego and Battleship,or games that simulate global conflicts like Risk and Axis and Allies, students will have fun learning geography and history while battling their friends. Students will learn to play these games, developing winning strategies both alone and in teams. Concepts that have been taught during the year in social studies classes will also be integrated into this course.

The Summer School Swim Program, located at the High School pool, provides instruction to students of all ages and abilities to develop their swimming and water safety skills. It is designed to give students a positive learning experience. **Classes are open** to students registering for other Summer School classes and to students preferring to take only Swim Class.

Age Limit: To participate in Swim classes children must turn four (4) years old by June 1, 2025. All students must be willing to stay with their instructor and group for the entire class time. Parents or children not enrolled in swim classes are not allowed in the water during summer school lessons.

Students must bring their own swimsuits and towels every day. Swim goggles will be provided. Swim caps may be worn. Flotation devices will be provided by the pool, when needed.

Swim Class Schedule and Skill Levels:

For registration, choose Skill Level and Period. Children are grouped according to their skill level and comfort with water. If this is your child's first year of Swim Classes, please register for Level 1.

Level 1 Periods: 1- 6	Introduction to Water Skills: helps students feel comfortable in the water and to enjoy the water safely. (Kreative Kindergarten may register for Period 5 or 6 only).
Level 2 Periods: 1- 6	Fundamental Aquatic Skills: gives students success with fundamental skills.
Level 3 Periods: 1- 6	Stroke Development: builds on the skills in Level 2 by providing additional guided practice.
Level 4 Periods: 1-5	Stroke Improvement: develops confidence in the strokes learned and to improve other aquatic skills.
Level 5 Periods: 1-5	Stroke Refinement: provides further coordination and refinement of strokes.
Level 6 see options	Swimming and Skill Proficiency: refines the strokes so students swim them with ease, efficiency, power and smoothness over greater distances.
	Students choose one of four options , each focusing on preparation to participate in more advanced courses. Each of the options includes all strokes learned in the first five levels:
	Fitness Swimming (Periods: 1 & 5) - learn about competitive swimming fundamentals. Personal Water Safety (Period: 3) - a precursor to Water Safety Instructor training. Lifeguard Readiness (Periods: 2 & 4) - precursor to Lifeguard training basic skills of lifeguard and water rescue.
