

**ACT/ “DO’s” and “DO NOT’s” for KHS Students**  
**March 9<sup>th</sup>, 2021**

**DO’s:**

- Arrive to check in at your assigned room by posted time.
  - ACT DAY= Begin arriving to your room at 8:15 a.m.
  - Each Junior Advisement Teacher has a list and can inform you of your assigned room for each day.
- Bring at least three sharpened soft lead No. 2 pencils with good erasers
  - Students *cannot* use mechanical pencils or ink pens.
  - A limited amount of pencils will be available in each room for those students who forget to bring one.
- Bring an approved calculator or two to be used during the Mathematics Test.
  - See ACT Calculator Policy – August 5, 2019 (attached)
  - KHS does not have extra calculators. Students are responsible for bringing their own- ACT approved- calculator for use during the tests.
  - Get your calculators cleared and checked each morning in the Commons. Calculators must be checked prior to arriving in the testing room. Available beginning at 7:30 a.m.
- Try your best because your ACT scores will be going to the technical colleges and universities of your choice for FREE. *Scores are good for up to 5 years!*

**DO NOT’s:**

- DO NOT bring a cell phone, fitness band, Apple watch, or any other electronic device that has internet capability.
  - You may not be in possession of a cell phone or any other electronic device at any time, including during the break, on testing day.
- DO NOT share a calculator with any other student.
- DO NOT bring textbooks, scratch paper, notes, or reading material with you.
- DO NOT bring highlight pens, colored pens or pencils, correction fluid or tape.
- DO NOT bring or wear anything into the testing room that may distract other test takers; ie: strong smelling perfume or cologne.
- DO NOT bring food or beverages, including water, into the testing room on ACT day.
  - A snack will be provided to you during your first 15 minute break on ACT day.
- DO NOT choose your own seat once you check-in
  - Each examinee has an assigned seat with corresponding test materials.
- DO NOT engage in any prohibited behavior in the testing rooms or during breaks. If you do, your scores will not be counted.
