Winter Swim Lessons

The Kiel High School Pool will be having an open registration session on Saturday, January 6, 2018, from 8:00-9:30 am at the pool for the fall swimming lessons. Kiel Area School District Residents may register their children throughout the session. Those from outside the district are asked to wait until after 9:00 am that day to register their children. Payment for the lessons will need to be made in order to reserve a spot in the lessons. Phone and email requests will be replied to following the registration session, however, payment will still need to be made in order to reserve a spot. Persons may also register for the lessons during lap swims or open swims after January 6.

The lessons will start on Saturday, January 13, 2018, and run each Saturday through March 3, 2018. Levels 1 through 6 will be offered at 8:00 am and 9:00 am with level 1 and our parent/toddler program being offered at 10:00 am. All level 1 through 6 classes are 45 minutes and the parent/toddler class is 30 minutes. *Students must be at least 4-years-old by the first day of class in order to participate in Level 1*. Students younger than 4 may participate in the parent/toddler class. Fees are \$25 for students residing in the Kiel Area School District and \$35 for students from out-of-district. Again, fees will need to be paid in order to reserve a spot in the lessons.
